# **General Description**

The Continuity of Care (COC) Therapist will be responsible for providing diagnostics and intake assessments for individuals on probation or parole for the twelve (12) county area. This includes determining if presenting criteria qualify the individual for admission to Center services and/or require referral to community providers. Additional responsibilities include: Perform emergency mental health assessments to determine if presenting individuals require crisis resolution or admission to inpatient hospitalization; Coordinate scheduling, dispatch, triage and appropriate disposition of assessments and interventions. This individual will work according to established contract guidelines and standards including adherence to Medicaid and Accreditation standards. This position will travel to the outline counties. The COC Therapist reports directly to the TCCOOMI Service Director.

### **Education**

Required: Master's degree in Social Work, Psychology, Marriage and Family Therapy or counseling form an accredited college or university.

### **Experience**

Preferred: Six (6) months' full-time direct care experience to individuals in a mental healthcare setting. Six (6) months' direct care experience in mental health screening and assessment. Six (6) months' direct care experience in mental health screening and assessment with both adult and child/adolescent populations.

#### Licenses/Certifications

Required: Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), Licensed Marriage & Family Therapist (LMFT), Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Psychologist with the State of Texas. Required: Valid Texas driver's license.

### **Special Requests or Comments**

Required: Must have visual and auditory skills sufficient to evaluate and monitor client needs; mobility required to bend, reach, lift (up to 50 lbs.) while assisting clients, completing Satori Alternatives to Managing Aggression (SAMA), CPR, First Aid, and Defensive Driving training modules, and carrying charts and equipment during a work day. Fine motor skills are required for legible writing and driving of a motor vehicle for business related travel required to attend trainings. Must have a driving record insurable by Burke's insurance administrator.

### **Hours**

Generally, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. However, this position may require after-hours work to complete job responsibilities.

### **Salary**

\$55,000 annually.

# Notice to All Prospective Burke Applicants
